**Farm Property Tax Credit Program** – Even minor changes in ownership or farm tenants can have a dramatic effect on your assessment and taxes. Please call, Ontario Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs (**OMAFRA**) at 1-877-424-1300.

### From the Public Works Department

**Keep Our Roadways Safe:** With spring here, it is important to remind people not to plant crops in municipal right of ways. As crops grow taller and fuller through the spring and summer seasons they can obstruct visibility as motorists approach rural intersections. Works staff have the authority to cut down any crops planted on Township road allowances.

**Construction season is almost upon us.** When you see  be aware that you are entering a work zone with people & equipment ahead. Workers are repairing/improving the road to keep it safe for everyone to use. Please slow down, pay attention and be prepared to stop. We want to see that these workers get home safely to their families each and every day. If you see  it means that the road is impassable and you must take an alternative route.

The Township Office is able to process your request for a Criminal Record Check/Vulnerable Sector Check. If you require a Vulnerable Sector Check, the OPP requires a letter from the organization stating that you require this check along with a signature. It is required by you to bring 2 acceptable pieces of identification: Driver's License, Passport, Birth Certificate, Hunting License, Blood Donor Card or Student Card. We cannot accept a Health Card as identification.

#### Wood Chips:

When available, free of charge, Monday -Friday between 7am & 3:30 pm. Please call the shop, 519-463-5389, for availability of wood chips.

#### Public Works Yard/ Leaf Waste Depot:

Open 24/7 to drop off yard waste. Please remember not to leave planter boxes or bags in the piles.

Wedding season is upon us! Did you know that you can purchase your marriage license at the Township Office? The license must be obtained within 3 months of the marriage date. There is a fee of \$100 to issue the license. Please see our website for further information.

**Controlled Burns:** All non-fire-pit burns must be called into the Township Office. This helps us to make sure that fires are being performed in a safe manner, as well as making sure that firefighters are only dispatched to real fires. This saves resources and makes sure that when a fire emergency happens, people and vehicles are available. Failure to call in a burn could mean that you'll be faced with the expense of dispatching firefighters out.

**Fire Safety Plans:** Spring is the perfect time to make sure everyone in your home knows what to do in case of an emergency. Ensure you have a fire safety plan and that everyone knows at least two ways to exit your home and where your meeting area is.
